This is an approximate layout for the top face of the stone. Slight variation may occur to fit the curves of the natural stone. The top crest measures 7.5" x 7.5". The side photos each measure approximately 7" x 5". They are all printed on enameled steel, and are made to withstand the elements, both colour and black and white. They will not bubble or tarnish. The plate is made from durablack aluminum and is also a product made to withstand the elements. We make the City's bench plaques from this material. All will be affixed to the stone with our monument adhesive. The text on the plate is 1/4" in height.
