SUBJECT: UBCM COMMUNITY RESILIENCE INVESTMENT PROGRAM - 2024 FIRESMART COMMUNITY FUNDING & SUPPORTS

At their September 23, 2024 Regular meeting, Council passed the following resolution:

"THAT Council receive the memorandum titled "UBCM Community Resiliency Investment Program - 2024 FireSmart Community Funding & Supports, dated September 9, 2024 and respectfully submitted by the Acting Manager, Emergency Management;

AND FURTHER, that Council enters the agreement with the UBCM and authorize the expenditure of the \$200,000 grant, funded entirely from the UBCM Community Resiliency Investment Program - 2024 FireSmart Community Funding & Supports, for the "2024 FireSmart Community Resilience Project(s)."

We are currently seeking Council's approval to expend the 2025 portion of the approved \$400,000 grant (Attachment 1), up to the amount of \$200,000.
