

Physician Numbers and Recruitment Efforts

- Currently: 58 Family Physicians
- 4 new recruits in 2024-2025 (2 from UK)
- Maintaining numbers given pending retirements
- Support from pharmacists
- Regional Interior Recruitment working group
- Kamloops and Colwood models to support physician recruitment



North Okanagan Family Practice Residency

- Physicians stay where they train
- Welcomed first 4 residents June 2024
- Collaboration with Community Futures: Murphy's Landing
- 3 out of the 4 residents plan to stay in the community
- Additional 4 residents in June 2025
- Very optimistic that the Residency program will be effective in recruiting and retaining family physicians



Nurse Practitioner Recruitment

- 7 Nurse Practitioners in Vernon provide Primary Care
- Attached over 4,000 patients
- Preventing patients from becoming orphaned as family physicians retire

Primary Care Network Hub


- Officially opened in June 2024 at Vernon Health Centre

Vernon Urgent & Primary Care Centre (UPCC)

Attached >2,300 patients & averaging 73 patient encounters per day

Updates since walk-in clinic closures

- Care Connect IDA Pharmacy Walk-in Clinic opened
- After Hours Phone Line
- Vernon Primary Care Network Hub opened
- 2nd Vernon Urgent and Primary Care Centre was approved
- 570 patients have been attached from the Health Connect Registry (September 2024 –

April 2025)









Measles update

- Increasing infections across Canada, with some now in BC (none yet in Interior Health)
- Actively promoting and reaching out to families of children who are not up to date with measles vaccinations
- Extra immunization clinics at Vernon Health Centre
- Vernon measles vaccination rate


2-year-olds: ~76%

7-year-olds: ~64%



Exposure locations

This list includes known exposure locations where public health is unable to identify and contact everyone who may have been exposed. If you may have been exposed, monitor for <u>symptoms of measles</u>. People who are most at risk of infection are those who are completely unvaccinated against the disease, including children under one year of age.

On Demand STI Testing Program

- Patients can receive STI testing (chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, and HIV) without needing to see a healthcare provider
 - Expanded to Vernon on June 1st
 - Interior Health Lab at Vernon Jubilee Hospital
 - Dynacare labs
 - 30th Avenue
 - Anderson Way
