Subject:	Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw 6048 and Municipal Ticketing Information Bylaw 6049	

<u>Purpose</u>: To seek Council approval of Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw 6048 and Municipal Ticketing Information Bylaw 6049.

Recommendation:

THAT Bylaw 6048, "Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw 6048, 2025", be read a first, second and third time.

THAT Bylaw 6049, "Municipal Ticketing Information Bylaw 6049, 2025", be read a first, second and third time.

Background:

a. Rationale:

Protective Services identified numbering errors within the Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw 5250 and requested an amendment. As both "Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw 5250, 2011" and "Municipal Ticketing Information Bylaw 5300, 2011" were adopted in January 2011, and are well over 10 years old, it was determined that a full review would be conducted and new bylaws drafted for Council's consideration.

Protective Services liaised with other departments to provide input on various updates to be included in the bylaws. In addition, the updated bylaws incorporate the fines for Short Term Rentals as identified through Business Bylaw 6100. A summary of changes is outlined in the two tables below.
