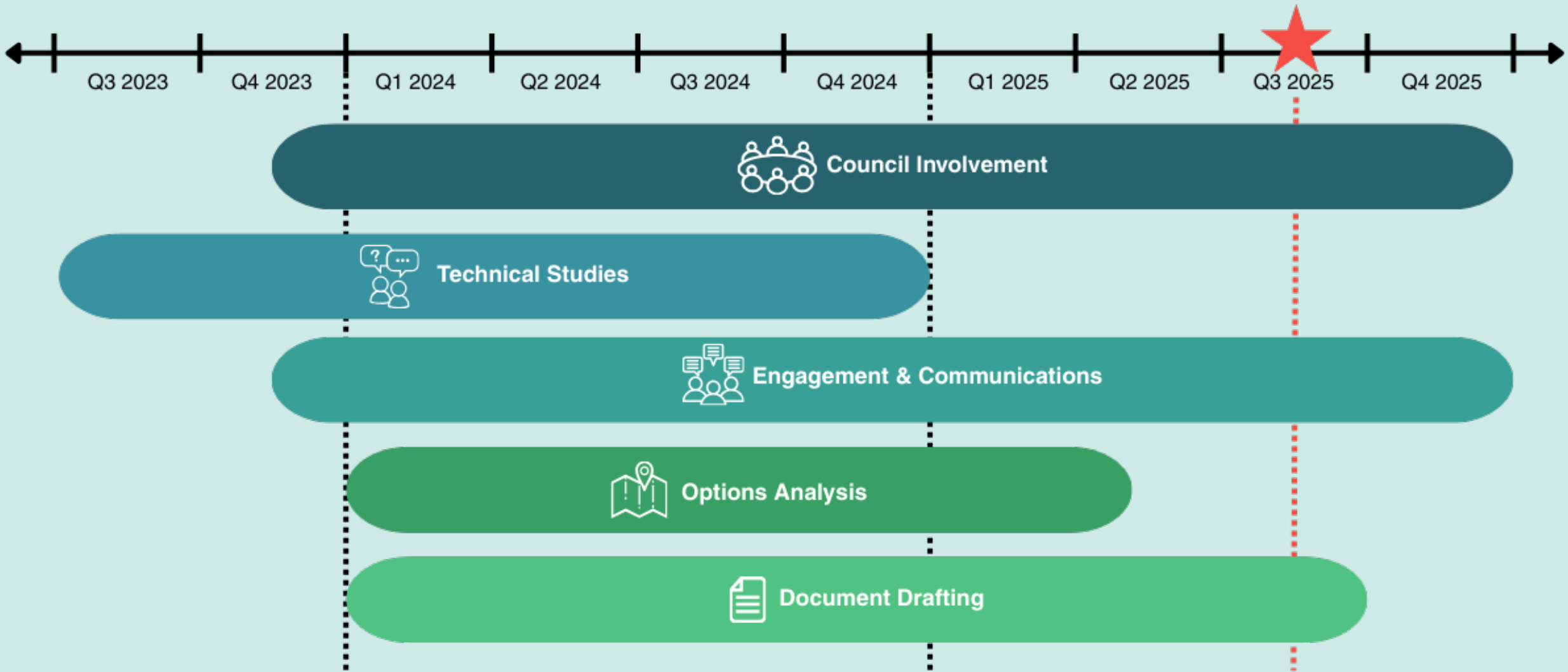
Why Update the Official Community Plan Now?

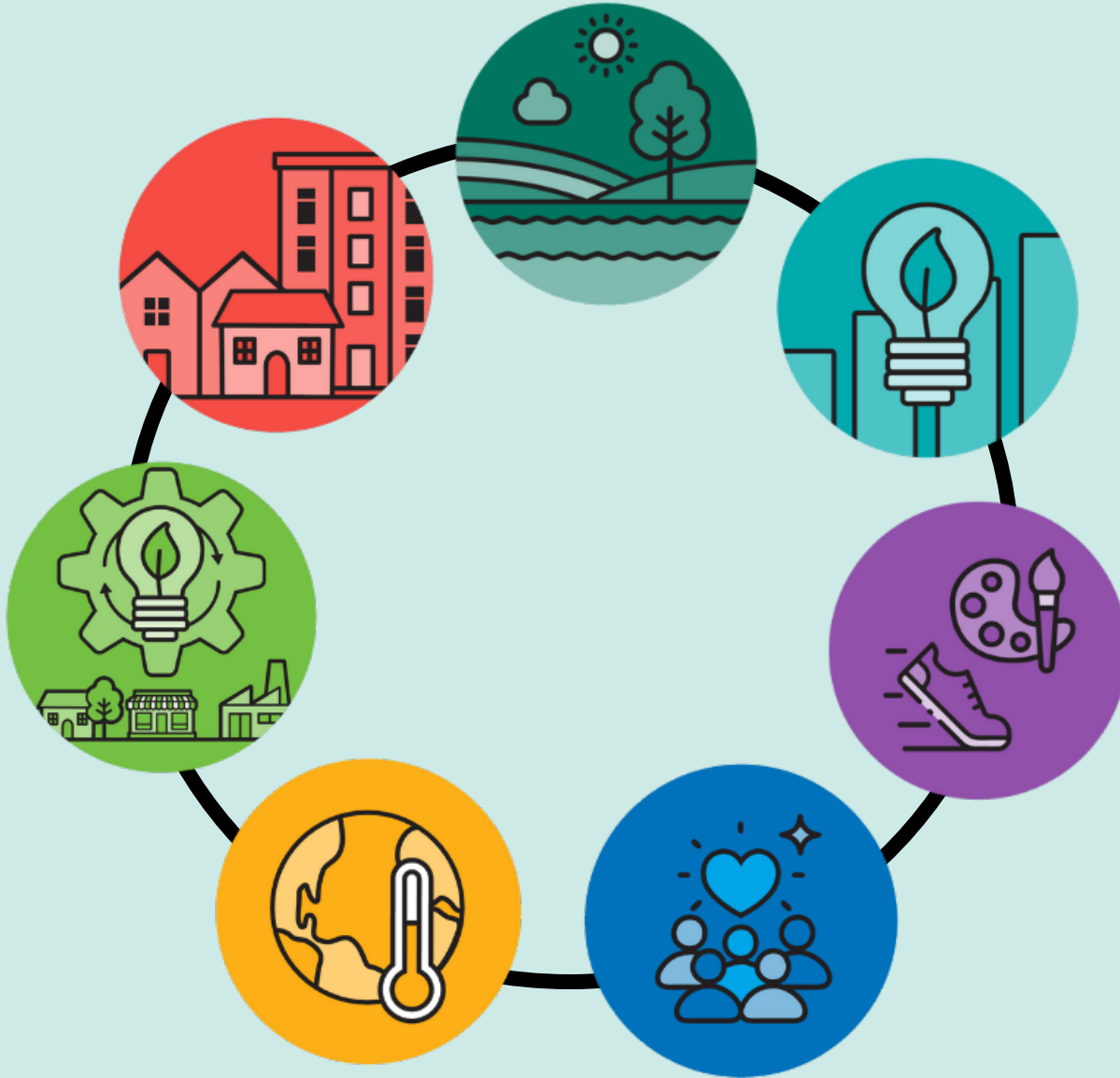

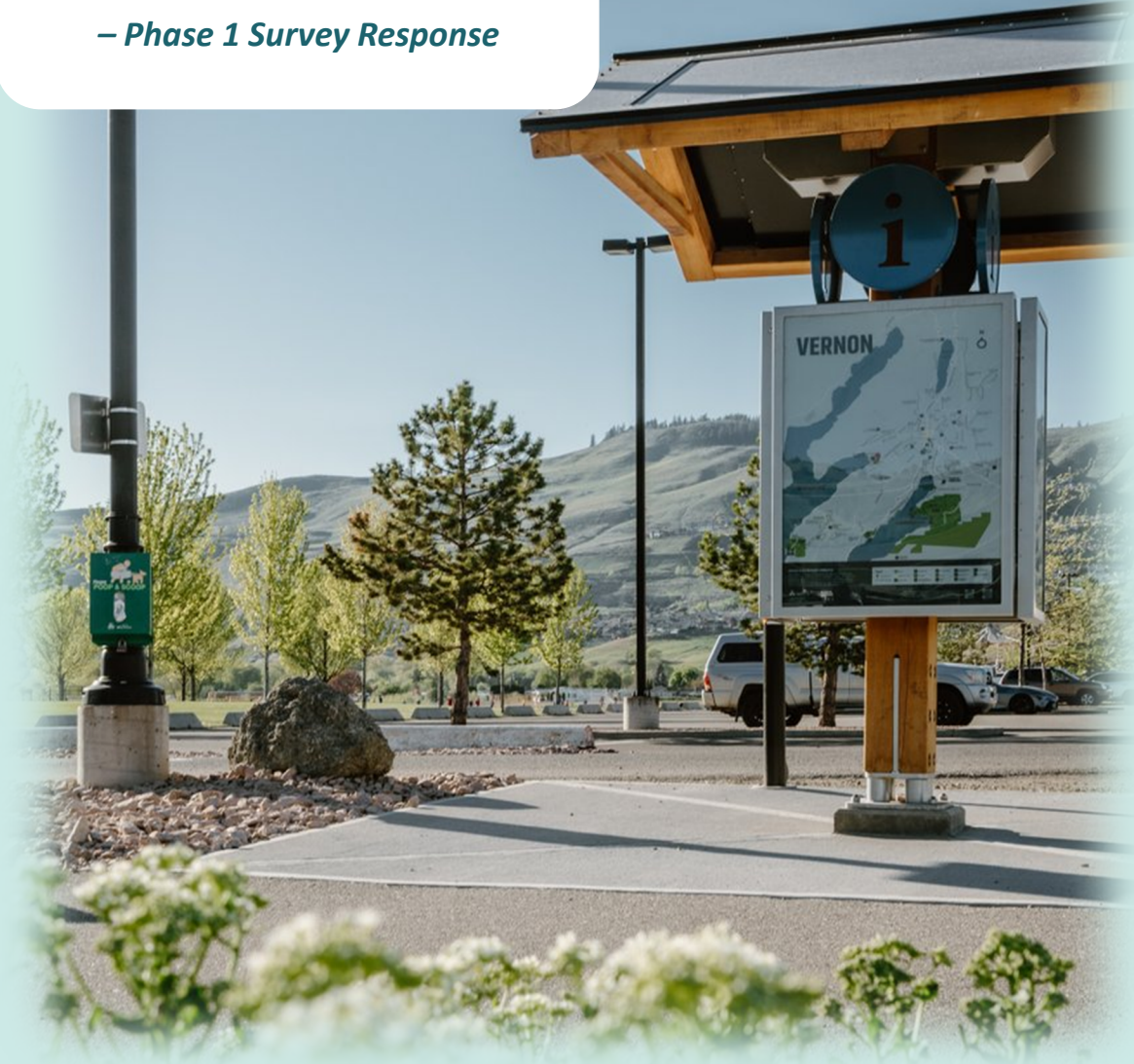

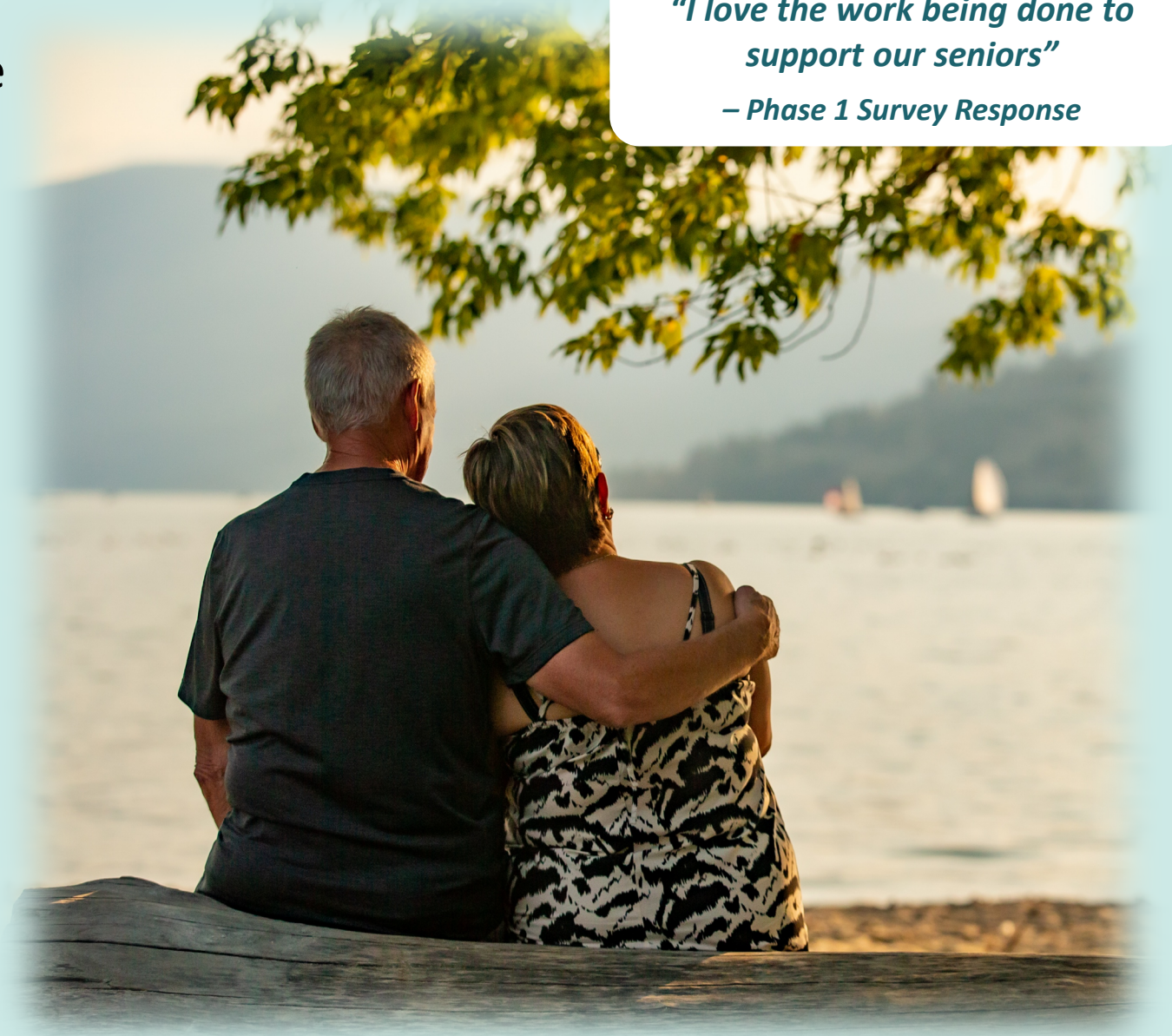
What's Next? – 2027 and Beyond
