to enjoy.



Thank you to Okanagan Indian Band leaders and elders for sharing the Syilx culture with the Vernon community.

sqilxw / syilx People

The Okanagan Indian Band is a part of the Syilx Nation. The Syilx Nation extends across the 49th parallel and is a transboundary Nation. It comprises 7 communities on the Canadian side and one confederated tribe on the United States side. The Okanagan Indian Band is the most northern community of the Nation and neighbours the Upper Nicola Band to the west and Westbank First Nation to the south. The distinction between the Okanagan Indian Band and the other Syilx communities is based on location and linguistic dialect.

syilx – The term is an nsyilxcn translation for the people who speak nsyilxcn.

sqílx^w – The Ńsyilxčń term for Indigenous person. It

can be understood as human. It translates as "the dream in a spiral".

These two terms are often used to describe the Indigenous people who live in this area. Have you seen these terms?

Winter

kwu kscapt'ikwłm! We are going to story tell! In the winter months, this is the time sqilx^w/syilx people gather to tell stories.

Did you know that knpxwxwtan is the time of snow drifting. This period is from the full moon in January to until the new moon period in February.

During the hard winter season, this is the time to fish for ling cod. Have you ever seen ling cod?

Bare in mind that these phonetic pronunciations are approximations and that the specialized alphabet has to be learned in order to say the words correctly.

captikwł

capt'ikwł are sqilxw/syilx oral stories that embody the passage of knowledge, experience, and information from generations to generations. These bodies of literature help to understand challenges and issues that may come up, they help to define how sqilxw/syilx people do things, they help to create spaces to listen, learn and teach.

Traditionally, we as sqilxw/syilx people, tell capt'ikwł stories during the winter months when there is snow out. These stories help remind us of our responsibilities to ourselves, our families, our communities, and our land.

Each year I looked forward to the parade. It was my favorite

part of the carnival. I would bundle up in my snowsuit and mitts, carrying my hot chocolate, and head down to the curb. I would watch the floats in awe and jump with excitement when they would give out candy. One year, I got to ride on a float and it was an unforgettable experience. I felt like a celebrity. I told all of my friends that they should watch for me and when I saw them in the crowd my heart filled with joy. My favorite float of all was the Queen Silver Star float. Seeing all the beautiful girls in their dresses with sparking crowns felt like magic when I was little. My aunt had been Queen Silver Star and I always had dreams of becoming Queen or Princess Silver Star one day. My parents would take me to meet them when they made appearances and we would take photos. To me they were royalty and I was amazed and inspired by how kind they were.

The carnival brings much joy to my family and I. It has created many fond memories of fun experiences. I know that the carnival impacts many other families around Vernon just as it impacts mine. Now that I am older, I still love all of the events, but I also appreciate the unity that the carnival brings to our community. Young and old come together as volunteers, spectators, participants or simply community members looking for a way to enjoy our city. The Vernon Winter Carnival will always hold a special place in my heart. I cherish the memories it has given me and look forward to enjoying it for years to come.







The Magic of Carnival

My earliest memory of the Vernon Winter Carnival took place on a bitterly cold winter evening. Bundled in our coats and mittens, hot chocolate in hands, my family and I walked into Polson Park. It was dark and we could see our breath as we exhaled. We were there to see the hot air balloon glow. Standing at the base of these massive balloons, looking up at their colorful fabrics glowing against the night sky was a vision I haven't forgotten. My mom and I each picked our favorite one. Mine was always the rainbow balloon. This became our tradition throughout the years, to pick our favorite balloon. In the following days, each time we were out we would scan the sky looking for our favorite balloon flying overhead. After wandering through the park we found our way to the ice castle. I recall turning the corner and being starstruck by the view of the queen and princess Silver Star. I begged my mom to wait in line to take pictures with them. My 4 year old self came prepared, and wore my plastic Cinderella tiara so I could match the royalty. Like many girls my age, this was the highlight of the carnival. The Silver Star queen and princess always made the carnival even more enchanting.

In the 62 years that our beloved carnival has been around, it has evolved and grown. However, it has always kept its core goal of creating magic, and fun for families. From the Snow Sculpture competition to the Chili Cook-off, each staple activity is a family favorite. Of course, the event known to kick off the week of festivities is the parade. This is when town businesses and organizations show off the floats that they feel represent them, or our community, the best. My friends and I would sneak through the crowds of people to get up to the front. This would ensure that we would get a prime spot to catch the candy being tossed from the passing floats. Seeing all the dancers, singers, and performers throughout the parade was entertaining. So many volunteers, and individuals assembled together to create a wonderful performance.

The true magic of the Vernon Winter Carnival is in its ability to truly build community connections. While the events are fun and a welcome escape during long cold winters, the long lasting impact of this tradition is that it gives roots and connections to residents of Vernon. The significant number of volunteers and donors are a testament to this. The car-

nival brings out people of all ages to take part in events, to participate in planning, setting up and fundraising. It is this kind of community involvement that truly creates connection and a sense of belonging for individuals. This sense of community is what has inspired generation after generation of Vernon families to keep the carnival going. It is a tradition that brings people together, which is something we all need now more than ever.

My years growing up admiring the Vernon Winter Carnival princesses inspired me to reach a similar goal myself. Last year I decided to compete in the Miss Teenage Canada pageant. A pageant is something that would not have even been on my radar had I not seen these princesses achieve their goals year after year before me. I was successful in winning the regional title of Miss Teenage Okanagan, and was invited to be a national delegate in Toronto. This past year I have been honored to volunteer and fundraise throughout Vernon and the Okanagan to support local charities. I have built relationships with local businesses, and have been overwhelmed with the support I received from this amazing community. I learned that the journey to achieve a goal like this is not taken alone. It requires a community. This is the foundation that the Vernon Winter Carnival has built. It has inspired me to become an activeparticipant in our community, and the residents of Vernon to come together and support each other through good times and bad. This year, I will be wearing my crown and sash while I participate at the O'Keefe Ranch Blue Light Special event. It feels incredible to be the one taking photos with little ones who are just beginning to experience the magic of the Vernon Winter Carnival.

The impact of this event reaches far beyond a couple of weeks in February. It creates connections and social responsibility for current residents, and generations to come. I am grateful for the impact the carnival has had in my life, and look forward to being able to give back to this wonderful community it has created. This legacy of generosity is the true magic of the Vernon Winter Carnival.






