**FIRE PROTECTION REQUEST** 

On March 13, 2023 Council received a letter from Bob Fleming, Director, Electoral Area "B" requesting fire protection for Area "B", on behalf of the RDNO. The letter included maps of the area proposed to received fire protection.

In considering the request, the number of properties, size of the area to protect and fire services response times were considered. There are 43 parcels, 2696.2 acres of land and approximately 60 structures in the area. GIS was used to help estimate response travel time times. It was found that to serve the area from Station 1 or 2 response is estimated to be 24 minutes. The area could be reasonably serviced from Station 3 (Predator Ridge) within a 10-minute response time.

Station 3 does not have full-time staffing and any service provided to the area would need to be provided from Station 1, Station 2 or both. The potential revenue collected from an agreement for providing fire protection in Area "B" would not be adequate to resource fulltime staffing for Station 3.

If a service agreement was to be entered into at this point Vernon Fire Rescue Services could not provide timely service. The agreement would not have a positive impact on the residents of Area "B"'s Fire Underwriters Survey (FUS) rating. And providing service would deplete resources needed to service the City of Vernon. Other service agreements work when location, size and density are such that service can be provided effectively at a reasonable cost.

Administration recommends not entering into an agreement for fire protection for Area "B" at this time and that Council reconsider the matter once a full-time response has been established at Station 3.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**



#### Re: RDNO Electoral Area "B" Fire Protection Request

I am following up on previous correspondence we had regarding the potential to have the City of Vernon provide fire protection services to Area "B" properties in the Commonage from Lake Country boundary and including down Bailey Road. I am attaching maps for the proposed service area.

If the City of Vernon agrees to provide the service and prices the service extension, I would then arrange to petition the residents to determine if they are willing to pay for it. If extended, this service would be very much like the service agreements already in place for Kalamalka Lakeview Drive and for IR#6 on Tronson Road. The recent tragic house fire on Commonage Road might spur people living there to be receptive to a fee for service arrangement.
