SUBJECT: AMENDED FLAG POLICY

Operation Services has advised that the individual ('Community') flag pole has been ordered and will be installed behind the decorative rock fountain on the south side of Spirit Square. Delivery is expected within the next four to six weeks. In anticipation of the installation of the individual flag pole, Administration is seeking Council's direction through an amended Flag Policy (Attachment 1). This Policy was originally presented for Council's consideration on November 28, 2022 and was referred back to Administration for further development.

This single flag pole is not subject to <u>National Flag of Canada etiquette</u> (which serves as a guide for municipalities). Administration has also viewed the various policies adopted by other communities across Canada that permit the flying of 'Community' flags. This draft amended policy includes enhanced guidelines to deal with Community requests.
