SUBJECT:

2023 ICBC ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANTS

The Insurance Corporation of British Columbia (ICBC) offers grants to communities for capital projects that improve road safety. In 2023, the City of Vernon received \$136,400 towards the Priority Intersection Improvements capital project (Project Number 2020-27), \$25,800 towards the Transportation Safety capital project (Project Number 2022-30), and \$1,500 towards the Sidewalk Ramps capital project (Project Number 2018-17).

Administration recommends that the existing capital project budgets (currently \$514,529 for Priority Intersection Improvements, \$391,992 for Transportation Safety, and \$31,738 for Sidewalk Ramps) be increased by the grant amounts received. This will support ongoing work to implement transportation safety improvements across the community.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council allocate \$136,400 towards the Priority Intersection Improvements capital project budget, \$25,800 towards the Transportation Safety capital project, and \$1,500 towards the Sidewalk Ramps capital project from the ICBC Road Improvement Program grants as outlined in the memorandum titled "2023 ICBC Road Improvement Program Grants" dated November 14, 2023 and respectfully submitted by the Transportation Planner.
