**SUBJECT: ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGER REBATE**

The [CleanBC Go Electric Public Charger Program](#) offers rebates to install public electric vehicle (EV) charging stations. Under this program, municipalities can receive up to \$50,000 for fast Level 3 chargers and \$5,000 for Level 2 chargers.

As part of the Civic Memorial Park project, two EV charging stations were installed in the northwest parking lot – one Level 2 and one Level 3. The City of Vernon received a \$55,000 rebate from CleanBC for these installations in April 2023.

Administration recommends that this rebate be allocated to the existing EV Charging Stations capital project budget (Project Number 2021-37). This will support ongoing work to implement more public EV charging stations in the City (including six new Level 2 charging ports outside the Community Services Building) and conduct an EV charger gap analysis report.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

THAT Council allocate the \$55,000 CleanBC EV charger rebate to the existing EV Charging Stations capital project budget as outlined in the memorandum titled “Electric Vehicle Charger Rebate” dated November 7, 2023 and respectfully submitted by the Transportation Planner.
