3.a 2024 Infrastructure Program (5205-01)

The Manager, Infrastructure provided an overview on the 2024 Infrastructure Program, the following points were noted:

- Storm Maintenance and Asset Renewal
- Pleasant Valley Road (PV) at 39th Avenue Roundabout to include left hand turn onto 20th Street, reduction of grade into flattened intersection
- 32nd Avenue Reconstruction 20th Street to 18th Street Phase II

Pre approval has been provided in the amount of \$400,000 to fund pipe work for the water system at the 39th Avenue roundabout project.

An additional \$420,000 has been pre approved for phase II of the 18th Street to 20th Street pipe replacement.

\$180,000 has been allocated towards funding a scoreboard at the Greater Vernon Athletic Park.
