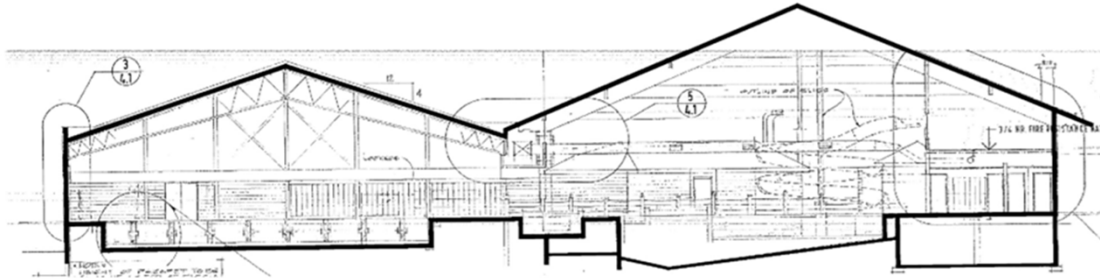
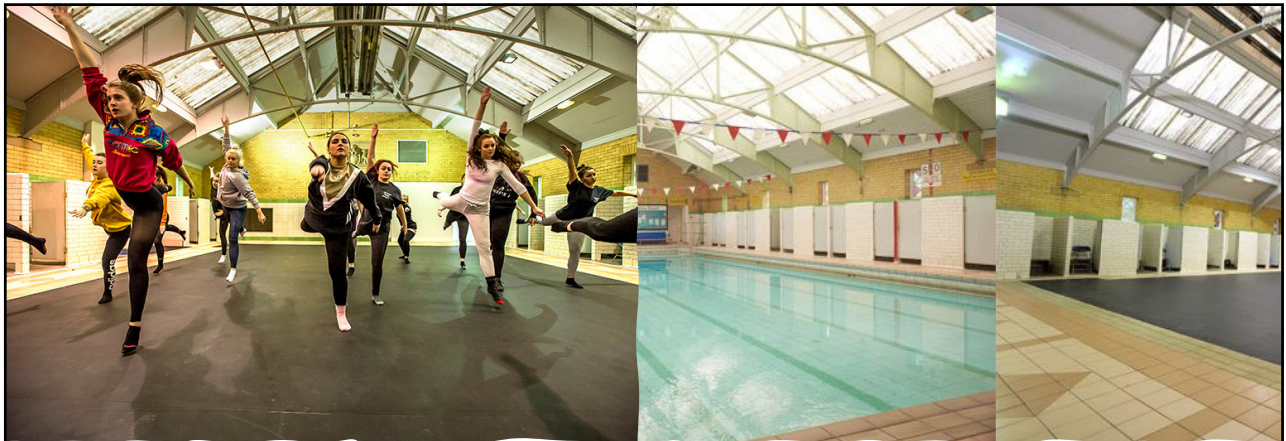

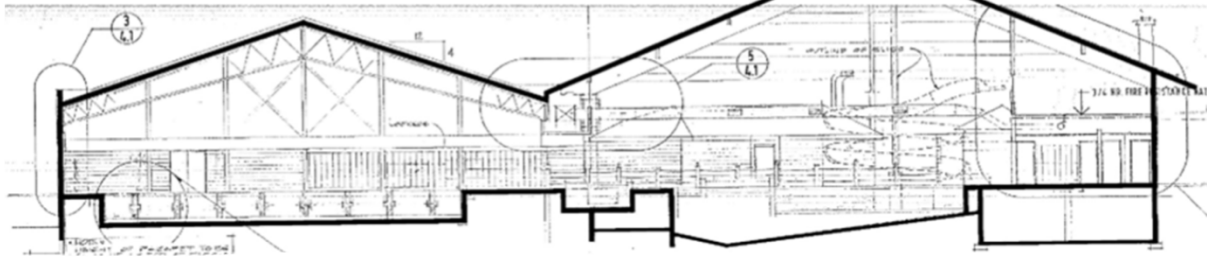

To gain further insight from Council into the space needs and opportunities for repurposing the Vernon Aquatic Centre and recreation site.



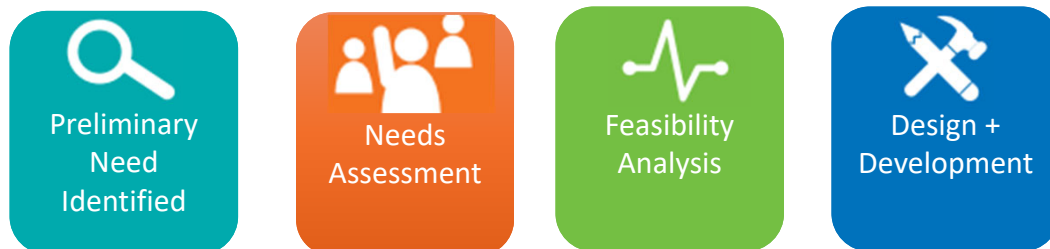


Repurposing Study– Scope

These steps are followed to ensure that new facility development is justified, operationally sustainable, and set up for success.

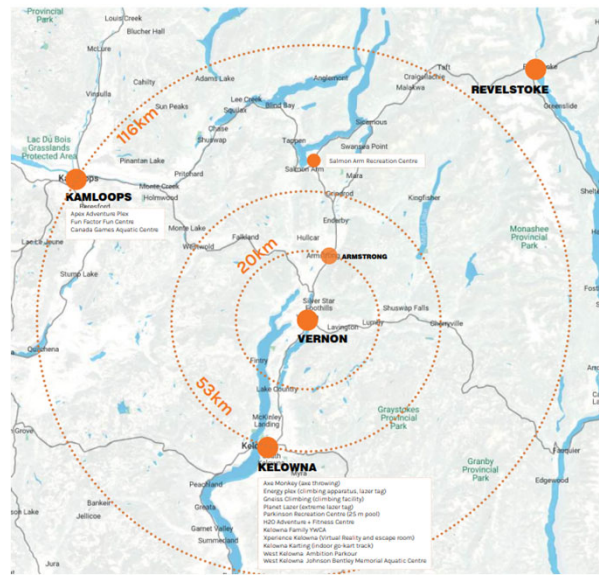
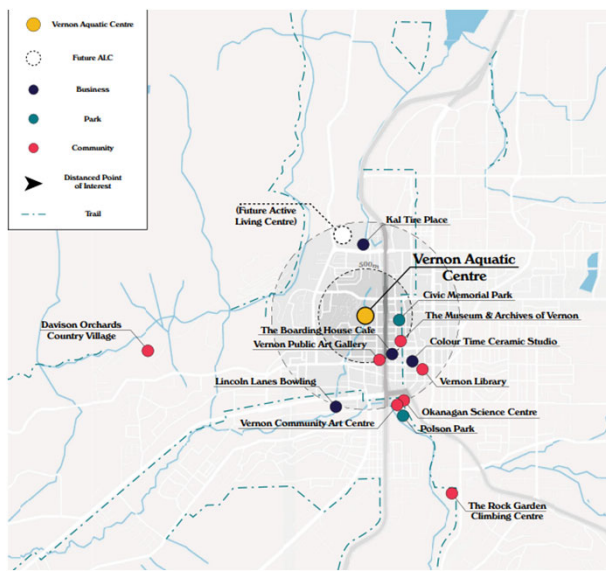

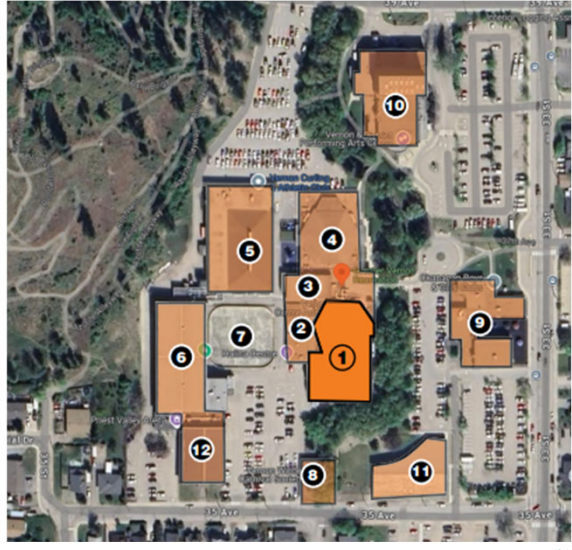

GREATER VERNON CULTURAL CENTRE
The Greater Vernon Cultural Centre will construct a new cultural facility in downtown Vernon, in which the local museum and art gallery will operate. It will be approximately 31,000 square feet and will include much-needed flexible/multi-use spaces for cultural activities, programming, and community gatherings that will be used by the local indigenous (Syilx) community, multi-cultural organisations, new immigrants, and the broader Greater Vernon community. **The estimated end date is Fall 2027.**

- A phased precinct plan needed

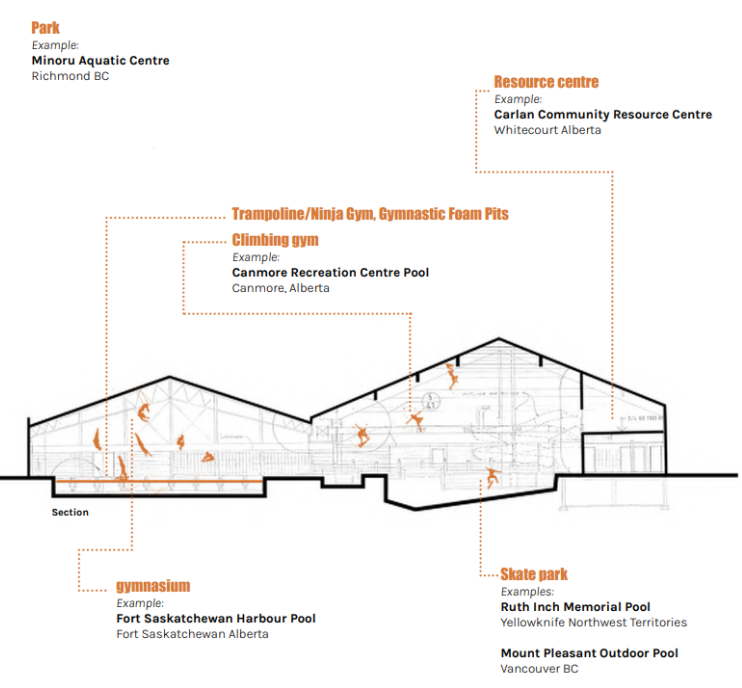
